Dear PCD Board,

Please accept this as a report for the 2007 PCD Chalice Camp. This program is a summer day camp serving Unitarian Universalists in the East Bay region. The week-long program for 1st–6th graders builds UU identity, community, and knowledge of UU history and theology. This year the program served 36 children from 4 churches, 2 middle school age youth as junior counselors, and 6 high school and college aged youth as counselors and counselors in training. In one week of Chalice Camp, we have more time with the children than in an entire church year of 45 minute Sunday morning "classes." It has proven to be a very effective way of delivering religious education. It also builds community among families in multiple UU churches.

While this Chalice Camp is the only one the district currently sponsors, we are pleased to report that individual churches in the district have also been offering the curriculum: Fresno and Davis are among them. The curriculum is also being used across the country by churches and conference centers. In early 2008, we plan to begin distributing the second week of curriculum, the successful Chalice Camp II, which focuses specifically on anti-racism and building just community in a developmentally appropriate and religiously grounded way.
