Dear Friends:

Enclosed is the official Notice of this year's Annual Meeting, which will be held at the Fremont Marriot in Fremont, CA, on Saturday, April 25, 2008, at 1:15 p.m.

In past years, we have sent each congregation enough packets for every delegate, only to find that many delegates never received their packet (and needed a new one at the meeting), or that a congregation didn't send its full compliment of delegates.

According to the PCD Bylaws at:

ARTICLE IV. PCD BUSINESS MEETINGS:

Section 3. (a) The Corresponding Secretary shall be responsible for providing notice of any PCD UUA business meeting to the members of the Board and to minister(s) and to the presiding officer or denominational affair chairperson of each member congregation. Such notice shall include the purpose(s) of the meeting, minutes of the previous business meeting, proposed agenda, all proposed resolutions, proposed amendments to these Bylaws, and relevant committee reports. Such notices shall be mailed not later than 30 days prior to the date of any business meeting. (b) Notices of Annual Meetings shall also include the current financial report.
