Three deans, many Youth Empowered Lay Leaders (YELLers), and the Primary On-Site Adult Leaders (PALs) will be working very hard to plan a great week for everyone that will be safe, engaging and all inclusive. **5-10th of July 2010**, mark the date!

Throughout the week there will be plenty of exciting and community-oriented activities such as workshops, worship, touch-groups and special events. Each day there will be three meals served either buffet or family style. There will **ALWAYS** be a vegetarian/vegan option. We try to meet everyone's dietary needs, given advanced notification.

Campers will be lodged in redwood cabins without electricity. Meals, and most other activities, will take place in and around the dinning hall. ## **WUUKY Covenant**

*You must bring this form with you to camp, or send it in with your registration information.*

As an attendee of WUUKY IX I understand and will abide by the following:

- In the conference community, youth are encouraged to express themselves in healthy ways and respect each other's boundaries. Behavior that breaks down the community, including sexual activity and sexual harassment, is inappropriate and therefore not permitted in a camp / conference setting.
- Youth in leadership positions are uniquely visible and influential in the conference community. Power imbalances exist in their interactions with other conferees. Youth leaders should remain aware of the impact of their actions and behave accordingly.
- As a Unitarian Universalist organization, we are a community that celebrates diversity and promotes the inherent worth and dignity of all human beings. Therefore, discrimination based on gender, sexuality, physical capability, race/ethnicity, politics, religion and even diet is not permitted.
- Violence and drug use are of course not accepted at WUUKY.
- All conferences are non-smoking, even for those youth above the age of 18.
- Youth may not leave the site except for in the case of an emergency or prior arrangement. If you must leave the site early, you must get a signed note from a parent or guardian except in the case of emergency.
- Please stay out of the kitchen unless you have the express permission of the cooks.
- Conferees are expected to recognize youth leadership.
- Attendees may not bring drugs or drug paraphernalia, pets, unregistered friends, or weapons. These will be confiscated until the end of the conference.
- PCD YRUU Council and WUUKY Staff reserve the right to deem any behavior inappropriate!
